

# CHARTER OF RIGHTS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE IN BIMBERI

The Charter is a guide to your rights and responsibilities while at Bimberi. It will help you understand how you can expect to be treated and how you should treat others.

## YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO...

- 1 Be treated equally with respect and dignity by staff**
- 2 Be kept safe while you are at Bimberi**
- 3 Be given a copy of Bimberi rules and information about your rights and responsibilities when you arrive, in a way you can understand**
- 4 Have a say about things that affect you, including decisions about your rehabilitation**
- 5 Remain connected to the outside world**
- 6 Receive proper healthcare**
- 7 Access education and programs**
- 8 Get help to see a lawyer and to talk to them privately**
- 9 Have good living conditions**
- 10 Practise your religion and/or express your culture**
- 11 Make a complaint**
- 12 Get help to successfully return to the community**

## YOU HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY TO...

- 1 Treat others equally with respect and dignity**
- 2 Follow the rules**
- 3 Respond to requests from staff**
- 4 Be respectful of others and their property**
- 5 Go to school and/or participate in programs**
