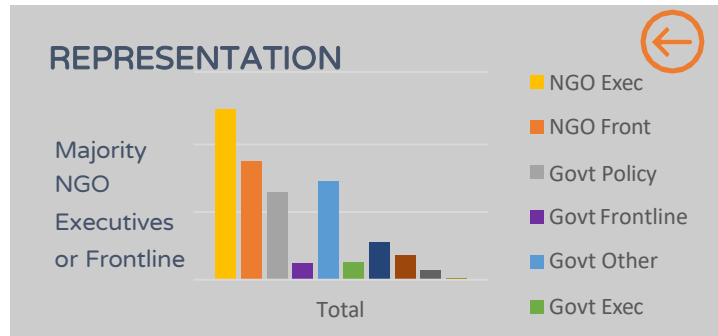
## ENGAGEMENT PROCESS



Round 3 is complete – with results remaining consistent on the use of collaborative design.

### COMMITMENT TO PROCESS

Respondents found activity very true or mostly true to the principles and priorities of the ACT Approach to Commissioning

**84%**

### COLLABORATIVE DESIGN

Respondents rated the collaborative design principles in the activity in use all the time or most of the time

**77%**

### TIME & ABILITY TO CONTRIBUTE

Respondents indicated they were always listened to or mostly listened to but only **63% (^)** felt they had enough time to explore the key issues

**89%**

### PROCESS & METHOD

Respondents strongly agreed or agreed that the process and method of engagement supported their involvement

**85%**

### OUTCOME & IMPROVING WELLBEING

Respondents strongly agree or agree with the outcomes reached through the activity with **55%** very confident or pretty confident the process will contribute to improving wellbeing

**70%**
